lot, piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in
the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville
in the Ward of the City of Greenville, having
the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning
at a stake on the south side of West Coffee Street
sixty (60) feet eastward from the south-east corner
of Coffee and Academy Streets (said stake being nine
inches eastward from the north-east corner of lot
no. 3 on plat made by C. M. Gurnan, dated February
22, 1920) and running thence southward almost (but not
quite) parallel with Academy Street, along line of lot
conveyed to me by L. O. Stokes by deed recorded
in the Office of the Register of Deeds for conveyance
for said County and state in Deed Book 89 at
page 54 (this line running parallel with and at
all points nine inches east of the joint line between
lots three and four on said plat) one hundred (100)
feet to a stake on a ten foot alley opening into
Academy Street; thence eastward along the north
side of said alley and beyond said alley in a
line with the north side thereof parallel (or nearly
parallel) with Coffee Street approximately twenty-nine
and a half ($29\frac{1}{2}$) feet to a stake on line of lot
still belonging to Mrs. Eileen B. Estes and Miss Johanna
Barneswyer, thence northward along line of last mentioned
lot approximately one hundred (100) feet to a stake
on the south side of Coffee Street; thence along Coffee
Street $77^{\circ} 69'$ west twenty-nine and a half ($29\frac{1}{2}$) feet to the beginning corner

This is a part of the land conveyed to me the said J. D. Bridges by the said Ellen B. Estes and Johanna Bernecker by deed dated July 30, 1925 and recorded in said office in Book 94 at page 469. On this lot I have just constructed a building known as 223 and 225 West Coffee Street. There is no lien or encumbrance on this property or any part thereof, by mortgage judgment or otherwise, except a balance of six thousand dollars and fifteen cents to be paid from the proceeds of the present loan remaining due on a mortgage (originally for forty-five thousand dollars) given by said Ellen B. Estes to W. Wilson Coors dated January 24, 1920 and recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 42 at page 216.
