according to said survey, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning on a stake on the north-west corner of Talley Street (formerly known as Pinckney Street) and Goldsmith Street, and running thence along said Talley Street N. 68° 50' W. one hundred (100) feet to a stake on line of lot conveyed to the said Jesse F. Fowler by Mr. and Mrs. Pannell, and re-conveyed to them by him; thence along the Pannell line N. 21-1/3° E. one hundred and ninety (190) feet to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence along said alley S. 65° 50' E. one hundred (100) feet to an iron pin on the north-west side of Goldsmith Street; thence along Goldsmith Street S. 21-1/3° W. one hundred and ninety (190) feet to the beginning corner. The lot intended to be covered by these presents was conveyed to me, the said Jesse F. Fowler, by the said L.O. Patterson by two deeds.

The first was dated February 20, 1915 and recorded in said office on February 22, 1915, in Deed Book 27, at page 499; the second was dated May 14, 1918, and recorded in said office on . May 17, 1918, in Deed Book 35, at page 323.

There is no other lien or encumbrance on said land by mortgage, judgment or otherwise, except a mortgage given by me to the said L.O. Patterson, as Trustee, dated July 26, 1923, and recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 31, at page 154.
