until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

 at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. P. Bonjers, H. Gower and Davis Furman

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the old Anderson Road about four and one-half miles south west of the City of Greenville, containing fourteen and nine tenths (14-9/10) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as is shown on plat of property of Bonjers, Gower & Furman by H. I. Jones, dated December 1912 to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the said Anderson Road, corner Thompsons land and running thence with Thompsons land S. 31-25 E. 1236.6 feet to an iron pipe, corner Thompsons and Chandler land; thence with Chandler land N. 87-17 E. 652 feet to an iron pipe, corner Chandler and Burton Land; thence with Burton land N. 37-31 W. 1483.5 feet to an iron pipe on Anderson road S. 73-28 W. 99.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence still with Anderson Road S. 67-35 W. 320.2 feet to the point of beginning
