WHEREAS,

in and by 1914 certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, James L. Webb and Maye W. Webb, executors and executrix of the last will and testament of C.S. Webb, deceased, well and truly indebted to J.W. Kirkpatrick in the full and just sum of Twelve Thousand, five hundred Dollars (\$12,500.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after this date.

with interest thereon from the date of April 1st, 1914 at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly.

and in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James L. Webb and Maye W. Webb, executors

and executrix of the last will and Testament of C.S. Webb, deceased
All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South
Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at a stake on the northwest corner of Pendleton
and Calhoun Streets and running thence with Pendleton
Street in a westerly direction a distance of ninety-one (91)
feet to a stake on the corner of lot formerly owned by
Bessie S. Lawton; thence in a northerly direction with line
of last mentioned lot one hundred and ninety-one (191) feet
to a stake on an alley; thence with said alley in an easterly
direction ninety-one (91) feet to a stake on said Calhoun Street;
thence with Calhoun Street in a southerly direction one
hundred and ninety-one (191) feet to the beginning corner;
and containing Seventeen thousand, one hundred and ninety
 $(17,190)$ square feet, more or less, being the same lot of
land purchased by me from Allen J. Graham by his
deed bearing date August 2, 1918, and recorded in C.R.C.
office for Greenville county, State of South Carolina, in
Deed Book 42 page 484.
