- (1) Lot no 26 in Block 2 of the subdivision of the lands of the Fountain Inn Manufacturing Co. containing 50 by 202 feet
(2) Also three lots #s 22, 23, and 24 in Block 1 in the subdivision of the lands of the Fountain Inn Manufacturing Co. on the West side of Shaw Street, containing 50 by 200 feet in each lot
(3) Lots #s 42, 43, and 44 in Block 4 of the subdivision of the lands of the Fountain Inn Manufacturing Co. and containing 50 by 150 feet in each lot.
