I, Addie M. Cox, of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING: WHEREAS, the said Addie M. Cox

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, Alexander Finlay well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of One thousand, one hundred and fifty dollars (\$1150.00) Dollars, to be paid One year after this date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alexander Finlay

all that piece, parcel or tract of land in Austin Township County and State aforesaid, containing thirty-seven and three-quarters (37 3/4) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 3x6m, on branch, and running thence N. 43 1/2 W. 13.20 to stone 3x7m; thence S. 53 W. 18.70 to a stone 3x7m; thence S. 30 1/2 W. 6.50 to a spruce pine 3x7m; thence S. 29 E. 5.75 to a stone 3x7m in the Pelham Road; thence with said Road S 44 W. 12.50 to a bend in said road; thence with said road S. 83 W. 6.07 to a P.O. 3x0m, in fork of road; thence S. 13 1/2 W. 3.05 to a stone 3x0m; thence S. 87 1/2 E. 8.19, 48. to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 74 1/2 E. 6.50 to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 54 E. 4.72 to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 39 W. 4.00 to a stone 3x0m, on branch, thence down meanders of said branch to the beginning corner.
