L. Walker*

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of *Greenville* State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, and State of South Carolina, about three (3) miles from the Greenville County Court House on the Augusta Road, and having the following netes and bounds according to a survey and plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, September 1922, to-wit: Beginning at a pipe on the Augusta Road, in the center of a thirty foot Street, and running thence with the center of said thirty-foot Street, S. 56.12 W. 617 feet to iron pipe in bend of said Street; thence still with said Street S. 22.47 W. 700 feet to iron pin, corner of Lot No. 27; thence with line of Lot No. 27, S. 8.15 E. 521.5 feet to pipe on a twelve foot alley; thence with said alley, N. 52.27 E. 1294 feet to iron pin on Augusta Road, corner of lot No. 2; thence with line of lot No. 2 and Augusta Road N. 18.10 W. 100 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 3; thence with line of Lots 3 and 19, S. 62.27 W. 604.5 feet to pin on a forty foot Street; thence with said Street and with line of lots 19 and 18, N. 26.31 W. 200 to pin, corner of lot No. 17; thence with the line of lot No. 17 and lot No. 5, N. 52.27 E. 601.5 feet to iron pin on Augusta Road, at corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the Augusta Road as a line N. 30.52 W. 609.7 feet to the beginning point.
