Burgess* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to *me* the said *Harold D. Burgess*

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of *Greenville* State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, on the West side of North Main Street between West North and College Streets, and being more particularly described as follows:-
Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street at Southeast corner of lot formerly owned by H. Endel, and running thence N. 72 W. 130 feet to an iron pin on a ten foot alley; thence along the Eastern side of said alley S. 18 W. 20 feet to an iron pin corner of lot sold by me to Cleveland and Brawley; thence with line of said lot S. 72 E. 130 feet to an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street; thence with said Street N. 18 E. 20 feet to the beginning corner.
This being a portion of lot of land conveyed to me by the Quick Built House Corporation by deed dated March 16, 1920, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 25, at page 502.
