in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville State of South Carolina, and described as follows: situate on the White Oak Road, about four miles northeast of the City of Greenville, S.C., containing Nine acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands of Waddell Estate, on East by lands of Redmon and Crouch, on the South by lands of Tanner, and on the West by lands of Greer, and being all of the same property conveyed to me by E. Greer by deed dated July 3, 1922 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 89, page 89, and by H.F. Tumblin by deed dated Jan. 27, 1920 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Vol. 66, page 394, with the exception of one acre heretofore conveyed by me to E. Greer, leaving Nine acres, more or less.
