All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land known as the "Sandelin" place, situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, containing One hundred and thirteen and one-half acres, more or less, and bounded by the Rutherford Road and by lands of, or formerly Mrs. Settles, Mrs. Vaughan, James Priestly, J.B. Hudson and others, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stone on the Rutherford Road and running thence S. 45 E. 22.35 to a stone; thence S. 55 1/2 W. 9.90 to a stone; thence S. 23 E. to a stone; thence N. 63 E. 12.47 to a stone; thence N. 23 W. 24.95 to a stone; thence S. 60 1/2 W. 3.60 to a stone; thence S. 88 1/2 W. 1.50 to a stake; thence N. 22 W. 11.40 to a stone; thence N. 63 1/2 E. 15.35 to a stone; thence N. 23 W. 14.85 to a stone; thence N. 29 1/2 W. 13.75 to a stone; thence N. 39 1/4 W. 11.35 to a stone on the Rutherford Road; thence along with the road 19 chs. to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by A.H. Miller. Also all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated in Glassy Mountain Township County of Greenville, on both sides of Bellue Creek, waters of South Pacolet River, about two miles from Gwansville, containing 115 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of John L. Pierce, T.M. Belue and others. Said tract is the same conveyed to the grantors by J.W. Gray, Master by deed dated March 31st, 1913 in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 22 page 228.
