Now, know all men, that said mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and for the purpose of securing the payment thereof, and in further consideration of the sum of one dollar paid to said mortgagor by said mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery hereof (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said mortgagee and his heirs, successors and assigns all that Greenville certain lot, piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of...... GreenvilleTownship. on the North side of the Spartanburg Road near the City of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the Spartenburg Road near the City of Greenville, said point of beginning being the joint corner of lots "G-6" and "G-7", and running thence North 48 degrees 32 min. West two hundred and 1/10 feet to an iron pin pin; thence North 48 degrees 33 min. East twenty-five and 5/10 feet to an iron pin; thence North 2 degrees 19 min. West fifty-two and 7/10 feet to an iron pin; thence South 48 degrees 32 min. East two hundred thirty-four and 2/10 feet to an iron pin on the North side of the Spartanburg Road; thence South 41 degrees 25 min. West seventy-three and 5/10 feet to the beginning point; said lot of land herein conveyed being known and designated as Lot Number "G-7" of the subdivision of the Overbrook Land Company, according to a survey and Plat there of made by H.Olin Jones, September 17th, 1913, which plat is of record in the R.M.C.
