and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further

promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any

kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, John L. Harrison

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. H. Goldsmith

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Fairview

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the East side of Oreeby River, on the Georgia road, having the following meters, and bounded according to a plat made by J. A. Adams, Surveyor, December 22nd 1909; Beginning at a stone 34 in the Georgia Road, and running thence with said road N. 64 1/2 E. 7.02 to bend in road; thence N. 64 1/4 E. 12.60 to bend in road; thence N. 75 1/4 E. 1.47 to stone 34; thence S. 25 1/4 E. 3.00 to bend in old road; thence S. 25 3/4 E. 9.50 to bend in old road; thence S. 33 E. 3.50 to bend in old road; thence S. 33 1/4 E. 7.14 to bend in old road; thence S. 43 3/4 E. 14.30 to bend in old road; thence S. 37 E. 1.95 to bend in old road; thence S. 45 3/4 E. 8.00 to bend in old road; thence S. 34 1/4 E. 3.20 to stone 34; thence S. 42 1/4 N. 28.61 to a stone 34 in line of tract no. 2 as shown on said plat; thence with line of tract no. 2 N. 29 N. 61.20 to the beginning, being known as tract no. 3 of the lands formerly owned by Edward Harrison, S.
