Looper, have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That T. W. C. Moore the said W.C. Moore and Martha L. Moore

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Zrown and W. P. Looper.

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

About three miles from Greenville Court House, being Lots nos. 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 of the subdivision of land conveyed to J.R. Zrown and W.P. Looper by Louise Earle and India Earle McFarlan by deed dated January 6th 1920, on a plat made by W. E. Dalton and W. H. Justice. Said lots have the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on the White Horse Road at the intersection of another road and running thence with White Horse Road S. 22 E. 2166 feet, more or less, to corner of Lot no. 21; thence with line of Lot 20 Southwest 350 feet to corner of Lot 21 and 20; thence with rear line of Lots 20, 19, 18, 17, 16 and 15, N. 22. W. 580 feet, more or less, to corner of Lot no. 15 on line of Lot no. 13; thence with line of lot no. 13 Southwesterly 294 feet to a branch; thence down said branch 175 feet to corner of Lot nos. 14 and 28; thence along line of Lot no. 14 N. 79-25 W. 311 feet to the old White Horse Road; thence along the line of the White Horse Road N. 11-01 E. 1914 feet, more or less to the beginning corner at the intersection of the old and new White Horse roads.
