securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Liberty Life Insurance Company

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

In Ward one in the city of Greenville on Academy Street, Beginning at a point on Academy St. 3 $\frac{1}{4}$  feet from Burncombe St. and running thence with Academy St. S. 24° 41' W. 43 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to an iron pin on Academy St. thence N. 64° 49' W. 84.2 feet to a fence post, thence N. 53.34 E. feet to corner of lot described in mortgage of the mortgagors herein to the Farmers Loan and Trust Co. thereto with a line of said lot 59 feet more or less to Academy St. the beginning corner and being all of the land conveyed to us by H. W. Philes, L. M. Wood and Mamie J. Smith as Executrix and Executrix of the estate of Thomas D. Smith, deceased, by deed dated May 24, 1917 and recorded in Vol. 34 page 41 except so much thereof as is covered by Mortgage given by us to The Farmers Loan & Trust Co. for \$10,000. — Reference to which is hereby made.
