Nannie D. Furman and *Sarah E. Barnes*all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, In the city of Greenville, on the

the ~~left~~ ^{right} side of Court Street: Beginning at a point on
 said Court Street, which is 67 feet $6\frac{1}{8}$ inches from a stone
 at the Southwest corner of Court street and the public
 square, and running thence in a southerly direction 47 feet
 $3\frac{1}{8}$ inches to a pipe on an alley; thence in a westerly di-
 rection 10 feet to gas pipe; thence at right angles with the
 last line and parallel with and 10 feet distant from
 the line of the Masonic Temple Company 53 feet to pipe
 thence in an easterly direction 10 feet to southwest corner
 of Masonic Temple Company; thence in a southerly direction
 20 feet $11\frac{3}{8}$ inches to corner of Southern Railway right of
 way; thence with center line of said Southern Railway
 right of way in a westerly direction 59 feet $8\frac{1}{8}$ inches thence
 making an angle of 89 degrees 45 minutes and running in a
 northerly direction with line of lot of T. C. Stone and others 121
 feet 5 inches to Court Street, thence making an angle of 90 degrees
 and running thence with said street in an easterly direction
 59 feet $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches to the beginning. Also an undivided one-
 half interest in a strip of land lying between the lot above
 described and the property of the Masonic Temple Company
 10 feet in width with a depth of 53 feet

Subject however to an easement of ingress and egress
 over and along a strip or alley way 8 feet in width taken
 from the western side of the lot herein first above described,
 and to an easement or right of way for the establishment and
 maintenance of an industrial spur track including a strip
 7 feet in width taken from the southern side of this lot,
 said easements being more fully described in the deed from
T. L. Donaldson et al to me.

Subject also to an easement this day conveyed by me to
 the Masonic Temple Company over said alley and right of
 way and also a strip of 130 feet $10\frac{1}{8}$ inches, more or less, north
 of said right of way.
