 day of 19 On three equal annual installments, one
 two and three years from date respectively with privilege
 of anticipating any or all payments at any time
 with interest from date
 at the rate of 6 per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually
 and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further
 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Stated, lying and being in the city of
 Greenville on the east side of West Washington Street, being
 known and designated as lot no. 3 and having the following
 lines and bounds, according to a plat made by C. M. Fulkner
 Jr. dated April 15th 1920 and recorded in Plat Book E; Page
 148 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County
 Beginning on West Washington Street at joint corner of
 Lot nos. 4 and 3, running thence N. 41° 40' E 15 feet to
 line first, on a 10 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 41° 40' E 15 feet
 to 18 feet to corner of lot no. 2; thence with said line N. 41° 40' E 15 feet
 to 8.41 - 40 and 7.5 feet to 2nd joint on West Washington
 Street; thence with said street N. 48° 52' W. 18 feet to the
