Greenville on the east side of West Washington Street, being known
 and designated as lots pro. 45 and following the following
 lines and bounds, according to the plat made by C. M^r.
 Garrison, Jr. dated April 25th 1830, and recorded in plat
 book "E" page 340 R. 97. C. office for Greenville County
 Beginning on West Washington Street at the front corners
 of lots 4 and 5, running thence N. 41° 14' E. 73 feet to an iron spike on a
 post in the Alley between S. 18° 53' E. 18 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot pro. 3, thence
 line of lot pro. 3 S. 14° 40' W. 73 feet to an iron pin on
