Now, To all whom these presents may concern: Whereas I, J.W. Allison am well and truly indebted to John B. King, H.V.G. Cooley and Peoples Bank of Anderson, S.C. as Executors of Mrs. Iola Cooley King in the full and just sum of twenty five hundred

Dollars, in and by me certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable as follows: in five equal annual instalments of \$500.00 each in one, two, three, four and five years respectively from December 16th, 1919

with interest from Dec. 16th, 1919

at the rate of eight per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I J.W. Allison the said

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John B. King, H.V.G. Cooley and Peoples Bank of Anderson, S.C. as Executors of Mrs. Iola Cooley King

All those two certain tracts of land containing respectively forty-six and one-third (46-1/3) acres, more or less, and

forty-six and six-tenths (46.6) acres, more or less, lying on Reedy River and adjoining lands now or lately belonging to Belton Sims, Thomas, and the the two smith tracts, and being the same tracts fully described in deed from Laura Hunt, et-al to L.F. Allison, dated February - - - 1919, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for County and State aforesaid in Book 50, page 269, and fully described in plats of J.P. Willis, Surveyor from surveys on the - - day of April 1901 and on the - - day of October 1912, respectively. Being the same land conveyed to me by L.F. Allison by deed dated the - - day of - - - and not yet recorded.
