 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Kirkpatrick

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Lot Ward Three on the south side of West Broad Street in
 the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and
 bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on said street
 55 feet eastward from the southeast corner of Broad
 and Jackson streets, and running thence S. 17° 30' W.
 (parallel with Jackson street) 100 feet to an alley; thence
 along the north side of said alley S. 72° 30' E. (parallel with
 Broad street) 45 feet to stake on said alley; thence N.
 17° 30' E. (parallel with Jackson st.) 100 feet to a stake on
 the south side of West Broad street; thence N. 72° 30' W.
 along said street to the beginning, subject, however,
 to reservations as to the walls and the use thereof as
