at the rate of eight percent with interest from date and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as provided until paid, interest to be computed and paid annually and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney fees, if said interest be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Mrs. Annie M. Southern, Executrix of the Estate of Jesse S. Southern, deceased, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money paid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and in consideration of the further sum of Three hundred and thirty dollars to be paid, and for the better

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. J. Southern, Executor and Annie M. Southern, Executrix, as aforesaid

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Yantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

beginning at a stake on the bank of Ruddy River, thence S. 63-10 W. 37.68 feet to stake in center of Augusta Road (stone on bank); thence from said stake with the meanders of said road S. 52-25 E. 212 feet to a bend in road; thence S. 81-03 E. 253.6 feet to a bend; thence S. 35-11 E. 449 feet to a bend; thence S. 10-04 E. 433 feet to an iron pin in center of Augusta Road and at the intersection of a field road with said road; thence with said field road as follows: N. 68-13 E. 324.5 feet; N. 66-48 E. 575.5 feet; N. 67-48 E. 466.5 feet to iron pin on edge of said road; thence by a new line N. 6-45 W. 542.2 feet to iron pin; thence N. 73-10 E. 717.5 feet to iron pin on an old dam; thence S. 83-15 E. 537.5 feet crossing the meanders of a branch to an iron pin; thence N. 62-15 E. 569.5 feet to a cross on a large rock on bank of Ruddy River; thence with the meanders of said river to the beginning; excepting however the following described tract of land conveyed by me to H.W. Chiles and W.P. Chiles by deed dated January 2, 1920, and recorded in Book 54, page 353; "On the Augusta Road about 5 miles below the City of Greenville, being a portion of the lands conveyed to Robert Sullivan by J.S. Cooper, beginning in the center of the Augusta Road at the intersection of a field road and running thence with said road N. 68-13 E. 490 to bend in road; thence N. 66-48 E. 780 to bend; thence N. 67-48 E. 706 to an iron pin in edge of said road; thence N. 6-45 W. 821 to a stone; thence N. 73-10 E. 326 to iron pin; thence N. 10-58 W. 12.84 to an iron pin; thence S. 63-10 W. 33.00 to center of Augusta Road; thence with said road S. 52-25 E. 321 to a bend; thence S. 81-03 3.82 to a bend; thence S. 35-11 E. 676 to a bend; thence S. 10-48 6.55 to the beginning corner, containing 47 acres, more or less, according to survey made by W.J. Riddle Surveyor, Dec. 20, 1919.

The tract hereby mortgaged contains 53 acres, more or less, being all that remains of the said tract of 100 acres after the conveyance by me of 47 acres to H.W. Chiles and W.P. Chiles.
