released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dora A. Goldsmith

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Known as Lots nos. 15 and 16 on plat of lands of Priddy & Patton Land Company made by R. E. Dutton, Engineer, recorded in Plat Book E, page 249, said lots having a frontage of 50 feet each on the north side of Judson road and each having a depth in parallel lines of 211 feet, lot no. 15 having been conveyed to me by Priddy & Patton Land Company by deed dated October 7-1920, and recorded in Book 53, page 432 and lot no. 16 having been conveyed to me by Priddy & Patton Land Company by deed dated July 28, 1920, and recorded in Book 53, page 421.
