NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That on the said 192nd day of July, 1917, J. A. Todd and F. C. Todd
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
 securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,
 in hand well and truly paid me and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Katie L. Pride

all that piece, parcel, tract or lots and situated in Austin
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Lying on Gilder's Creek, waters of Enoree River, known as lot no. 7
 on a plat of the subdivision of the Leonard lands by L. P. Eptor
 Nov. 1917 and containing 42.35 acres, more or less, and
 having the following courses and distances; Beginning at
 a stake in Gilder's Creek, corner of lot no. 6, and running
 S. 14.45 E. 7.35 to corner of Vaughan and Todd, thence N. 75.15
 E. 23.68 with Todd's line to a stone thence N. 10.15 W. 9.60 to
 a stone, thence N. 4.45 W. 17.10 to a black gum in Gilder's
 Creek, thence up said Gilder's Creek to the beginning
 corner, this being same lot deeded to me, J. A. Todd
 by D. W. Leonard and Roy E. Leonard by deed dated Nov.
 20, 1917 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County
 in Vol. 43 page 289.
