day of *December*, 19*20*.

with interest from *Dec. 23, 1919*
at the rate of *Eight* per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid... annually
and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I... have further
promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note... be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any
kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I... the said *N. P. Chapman*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me...
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *C. F. Dill*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Lusklin*
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

And being a part of the land described in Deed of *S. M. Chapman*
and *N. P. Chapman* as Executors of the will of *William P. Chapman*
by deed dated *December 23, 1919* and recorded in
R. M. C. office for *Greenville County* in *Vol. 60 page 15*, and
having the following metes and bounds to-wit; according
to survey made by *W. L. Mitchell* *December 3, 1919*. Beginning
at an iron *3 1/2* in the road, thence *N. 45 3/5 E. 11.47 3/4*
thence *N. 23 3/4 E. 7.86* to stake *340*, thence *N. 68 1/2 E. 10.38* to
stone *340*, thence *N. 53 3/4 E. 8.52* to stone *340*, bounded from
the beginning by *J. Ed. King*; thence *S. 62 5/8 W. 19.61* to stone
340, thence *S. 44 1/2 E. 11.92* to stake *340*, thence *S. 68 W. 17.52* to
stake *340* bounded by *Henry Green*, thence *S. 52 3/4 E. 5.74*
to stake *340*, thence *S. 60 1/2 W. 2.15* to iron *3 1/2* in the road,
thence along road *S. 51 1/2 E. 10.06* to the beginning, containing
29 4/5 acres. See also deed of *Bessie Harrison* to *N. P. Chapman*
dated *December 23, 1919* and recorded in *Deed Book Vol. 48*,
page *68* which conveyed her *1/6* interest therein to the said
N. P. Chapman.
