with interest thereon from Date by Semi-annually at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

all those pieces, parcels and lots of land situated lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, in Ward 5, and being known and designated on Plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "a" at Page 403, reference to which is hereby craved for a full description, as lots Nos. 2 & 5, fronting on Lower Street, lot No. 6, fronting on Queen Street, and lots nos. 11 and 12, fronting on Carpenter Alley.
