WHEREAS, *I*

with interest thereon from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including *per cent.* of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County and state aforesaid in Grove Township and on the Fork Shoals Road and containing 11 3/4 acres more or less and being a portion of the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of J. R. Putman. Bounded on the south by lands of Walter Kessett, on the west by Greenville and Fork Shoals Public Road, on the north by lands formerly owned by J. P. Nabor, on the east by Reedy River. This being the only mortgage on the within described land except a mortgage given by me to V. M. Babb.
