part or all at any time*with interest thereon from *date* at the rate of *7 1/2* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *quarterly*~~until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at
any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon
and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this
mortgage in the hands of an attorney for legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including

bargain, sell and release unto the said *A. G. Wilson*

All that piece parcel or lot of land situate in the city of Greenville County and
state aforesaid, over the south side of Tindal Ave and being more particularly
described according to plat made by R E Dalton, Engineer October 1920 as follows:
Beginning at ~~an~~ iron pipe on the south side of Tindal Avenue at the corner
of lot 38 block B of Eagle Park, which point is 551.1 ft. in an easterly direction
from the intersection of Tindal Avenue with Augusta Street; thence with line of lot
38 S. 4-10 E. 150.3 ft. to iron pipe; thence N. 89-07 E. 52.5 ft. to iron pipe corner of
lot 36 of block B of Eagle Park, thence with line of lot 36 N. 6-53 W. 150 ft.
to iron pipe on Tindal Avenue; thence with Tindal Avenue S. 89-07 W. 61 ft. to
the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land purchased by me from Roy
Robison off his deed dated May - 1921 and recorded in the office of the
R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 48, page 479.

It being understood that this mortgage is subject to and second to a mortgage
executed by me to Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States on
Oct. 22, 1920, to secure the sum of Fifty-Five Hundred (\$5500.00) Dollars, which
mortgage is yet unrecorded. Said mortgage to the Equitable Life Assurance
Society of the U. S. being a first mortgage over the premises above described and
this being a second mortgage over said premises.
