Dollars, to me 18 day of May 1922 3 years after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

any time paid due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MacMillan C. King, All my right, title and interest of, in

and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of East Court Street in the City of Greenville, being lot No. 4, of the property of C.C. Hindman as shown on plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, December 1919, recorded in the office of R.M.C. Greenville County, S.C., in plat book E., page 187, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on East Court Street 30 feet on the east side of ten foot alley; thence with East Court Street S. 71-39 E. 25 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 5; thence with line of said lot S. 18-21 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on eleven foot alley; thence with line of said alley, N. 71-39 W. 25 feet to corner of lot No. 3; thence with line of said lot N. 18-21 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor by J.D. Neal, by Thomas M. Walker Co. by deed dated July 24, 1920, deed recorded in Vol. 53, page 417 R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and said J.D. Neal having conveyed his one-half interest to the mortgagor by his deed dated Feb. 5, 1921, deed recorded in Vol. 64, page 298, R.M.C.
