until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

being in the City of Greenville, on Rhett Street, and known as lots Nos. 63 and 64 on the plat of the property of Thos. H. Walker Company recorded in Plat Book E., page 146 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin southeast corner of Rhett Street and an 18 foot street (unnamed) thence with Rhett Street N. 71-54 E. 11.72 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Rhett Street N. 39-29 E. 27-43 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots No. 64 and 43; thence with joint line of lots No. 64, 42 and 43, S. 36-36 E. 103.8 feet to an iron pin on 18 foot street (unnamed); thence with said 18 foot street S. 50-24 W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Street S. 69 W. 52.37 feet to iron pin at the junction of said Street with another 18 foot street; thence with last mentioned 18 foot street N. 10-57 W. 87 feet to the point of beginning.
