I, William E. Hughes, SEND GREETING:  
WHEREAS, I, the said William E. Hughes

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to  
J.W. Norwood  
in the full and just sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid six months per date hereof

with interest thereon from 12th day of Oct 1922 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually in arrears

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at  
any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon  
and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before  
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this  
mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including  
10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this  
mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood, All that certain tract or parcel of land situate,

lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Austin Township on Gilders Creek,  
branch waters of Fhoree River, and containg 130 acres, more or less, and having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at a sweet gum 3x; thence N. 8 E. 5.00 to stone; thence N. 25 E. 10.00  
to stone; thence N. 29 E. 10.20 to stone old line N. 39 W. 6.39 to stone in road leading  
to Westmoreland's mill; thence up said road N. 80 W. 3.30 to stone; thence N. 26 W. 8.50  
to stone; thence N. 29 W. 4.12 to stone in Anderson Bridge Road; thence up said road  
S. 50 W. 3.47 to stone in said road; thence N. 33 W. 8.22 to stone; thence S. 61 W. 25.00  
to stone on South side of road; thence S. 18 E. 40.30 to R.O. 3x; thence N. 68 E. 20.23  
to the beginning.
