and wife Wood, being that same tract of land conveyed  
to Mr. W. M. Miller by his deed of even date and  
formerly conveyed to W. M. Miller by W. Marion Tullison  
by his deed bearing date of Dec 5th, 1918, recorded in R.M.C.  
office Greenville County in Book "B" at page 181, being originally  
a part of the old Neffit tract, having the following preted
