be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

thirty and forty five one hundredths acres, more or less
occupied by land of Mrs Alice Garrison Bordie Garrison
and James Wood. Being that same tract of land conveyed
to me by Millego Milton by his deed of even date and
jointly conveyed to Millego Milton and W. Martin Garrison
by his deed bearing date of Dec 5th, 1918, recorded in W. M. C.
office Greenville County in Book "G" at page 181, being originally
