I, R. E. Griffin, of Greenville County SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said R. E. Griffin
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of eight thousand six hundred and ninety six (\$8,696.00)
Dollars, to be paid January 1st 1922

with interest thereon from maturity day of Dec 1921 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until in full, if interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said Pen (10%) further providing for an attorney's fee of one cent per dollar

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R. E. Griffin

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Norwood National Bank

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said R. E. Griffin

Witness John in hand well and truly paid by the said Norwood National Bank

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Norwood National Bank, its successors and assigns

forever, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid
and in the Town of Mauldin, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at the intersectin
of Greenville and Laurens Road and Jenkins Street, and running thence along Jenkins Street
One hundred forty-four (144) feet, more or less, to iron pin, corner of lot heretofore
sold by C.C. White to Maude Swicegood; thence along the line of the lot of said Maude -
Swicegood, one hundred fifty-six (156) feet, more or less, to an iron pin on line of property
of Frank Shaver; thence with the line of the said Frank Shaver one hundred forty-four (144)
feet, more or less, to the Greenville and Laurens Road; thence down the Greenville and
Laurens Road one hundred fifty-six (156) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner,
and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C.C. White by deed dated January 8th,
1921, and being the same land heretofore conveyed to C.G. White by A.L. Holland, by deed
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Book 43, page 202, less that
certain lot conveyed by me to Maude Swicegood on March 7th, 1918 by deed recorded in said
office in Book 43, page 359.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid
about six and one-half (6-1/2) miles south of the City of Greenville, and on the west side
of the Laurens Road, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake
near the northeast corner; thence S. 32-1/2 E. 1.53 to a stake; thence S. 42-1/2 W. 6.37 to
a stake; thence N. 47-1/2 W. 1.52 to a stake; thence N. 42-1/2 E. 6.80 to the beginning. This
land faces on the Laurens Road and adjoins lands of the Estate of E.S. Smith on three
sides, and contains One (1) acre, more or less. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me
by George A. Johnson, by his deed dated November 20th, 1919 and recorded in the R.M.C.
Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 53, page 255.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in the County and State aforesaid
on the Laurens Road, about six miles South of the City of Greenville, and containing One
hundred (100) acres, more or less, and represented by a survey and plat of the same made
for D.F. and F.L. Smith by R.E. Dalton, Surveyor and having the following metes and bounds
to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in Laurens Road and running thence along said road S.
37-30 E. 200 feet to bend; thence S. 19 E. 400 feet to bend; thence S. 18-06 E. 2100
feet to bend; thence S. 14-20 E. 114.9 feet to bend; thence leaving said road and running
thence N. 14-50 E. 1165.5 feet to stone; thence N. 14-40 E. 1909 feet to large stone;
thence N. 3-24 W. 300 feet to spike in Railway tire; thence along center of C. & W.C. Ry.
N. 3-24 W. 300 feet to bend in center of Rwy.; thence along said Rwy. N. 13-38 W. 400 feet to
bend; thence N. 25-28 W. 400 feet to bend; thence N. 37-42 W. 400 feet to bend; thence N.
37-42 W. 43 feet; thence leaving said Rwy. and running thence across spring branch near
spring S. 30 W. 2541.4 feet to the beginning corner in road. Being the same tract of land
conveyed to me by E.P. Taylor, by his deed dated January 1st, 1920 and recorded in the R.M.C.
Office for Greenville County in Vol. 55, page 148.
