interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said M. P. Hall, his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece, parcel, tract or plantation of land, lying and
being situated in the state and county aforesaid, near Paris
Mountain Road, about four miles from Greenville C. H. on
West side of Paris Mountain Road and being that tract of land
as conveyed to me, the said A. J. Smith, (by M. A. Bryant
by deed Feb. 2, 1920 and having the following meter) and bounds
A-wit: Beginning at a stone, Hubbard's and M. Carters' corner
thence S. 24 3/4 W. 5.27 to Pooler's corner, thence with Pooler's line S. 61 1/2
