bargain, sell and release unto the said Pichens' Bank their assigns and successors.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Butler's Force Mountain and Chick Springs
Twp. Greenville County, State of S. C., in and unto the said wife of Chickland
Road, about three and one-half miles from the city of Greenville, near the
White Oak Church Road, having the following metes and bounds, according
to a plan survey by W. H. Lusk, dat-ing date the first day of June 1909
to wit:

Beginning at a stake marking of land now belonging to G. J.
Lusk, extending thence along the line of 40 feet, to the south side of
the church road and running thence along the line of said highway
thence S. 87° 16' 24" E. 62 feet to a stone thence along the Bradley
Road and S. 97° 45' E. 303 ft. to a stone thence along the Bradley
Road S. 87° 66' 660 feet to a stone thence along the line of 18. H.
Lusk's road, N. 86° W. 1279 ft. to the beginning corner containing
A. 3. 1 acre, more or less, this being the land conveyed to Mr. Garneau
by W. H. Lusk, Esq. by deed dated Dec. 14, 1904 recorded in deed book 1997 on
page 389. The tract so described in said deed fifty acres and Garneau has
hereforever conveyed to W. H. Hudson five and one half acres, more or less by deed

the Daughers Land and running from the above described tract to the White
Oak Church Road, said strips of land having been expected by me
from the conveyance to W. H. Hudson of the said acre more
