until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten Per cent of the  
Amount hereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said L. P. Hillhouse

His heirs and assigns forever;  
All those certain pieces, or parcels of land

County and State aforesaid, described as follows:  
Tract no. 1. Containing thirty-five and three-fourths  
acres more or less, being more fully described in  
a deed to Henry Green recorded in R. M. C. Office

deed being hereby made.  
Tract no. 2. Containing thirty-four acres more or less,  
being the property of Rosa Green devised to her by  
the Will of W. B. Seaborn see Will Probate Judge's Office

Rosa Green for one-half interest of said thirty-four acres
