at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. F. Gallivan: All that certain piece of land and lot of land situated lying

and being in Ward Five of the city of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, on the West side of Moultrie Street, beginning at the post of Mrs. Mary Allen on Moultrie Street and running thence with said Moultrie Street toward Perry Avenue, Sixty-five (75) feet to a stake, thence in a line parallel with the back line of Mrs. Mary Allen's lot Sixty (70) feet in a westerly direction to a stake thence in the direction toward Pendleton St. parallel with Moultrie Street Sixty (70) feet to the line of Mrs. Mary Allen's lot, thence with Mrs. Mary Allen's line in an easterly direction, Sixty (70) feet to the beginning corner on Moultrie Street, containing 4,900 square feet, more or less and being part of the lot which was conveyed to Mary E. Turner by Mrs. Elizabeth T. McPhail March 14th A.D. 1908 by Deed recorded in the SMC office for Greenville County, in Vol. 101 at page 447 and the same lot conveyed to us by said Mrs. Mary E. Turner by Deed filed the 7th day of February A.D. 1909 and recorded in the SMC office for Greenville County, in Vol. 1030 page 305.

Also that certain other piece of land situated lying and being in the state of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Greenville Township known and designated as Block No. 3 of the Hokes Subdivision as shown on plat thereof, made by Wm. D. Myers, bearing date December 2, 1912 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County on February 7th A.D. 1913, in Plat Book "C" at page 24 and containing eleven and forty-four one hundred and sixteen (11.44) acres, more or less and having according to said plat the following written and bounded to wit: Beginning at a stake on the corner of Pendleton Road and Sturdivant (or Sturdivine) Street, and running thence along said Pendleton Road N. 15° 56' W. one hundred and eighty-six (186) feet to a stake on said road, thence N. 28° 18' E. one hundred and eighty-nine (189) feet to a stake on the west side of the said Sturdivant Street, thence along said street S. 34° W. sixteen hundred and eighty-eight (1688) feet to the beginning corner; together with one half of Sturdivant Street as shown on said plat, subject to such easement therein as may have been acquired by the public our intention being that this mortgage shall cover exactly the same property conveyed to us by J. J. Bell by deed bearing date March 13 A.D. 1919 and recorded in said Register's office, in Vol. 43 at page 276.

This mortgage constitutes the first and only lien upon the property last above described and the property first above described is free from all liens and incumbrances except a mortgage heretofore executed by us to said J. F. Gallivan and recorded in said Register's office in Vol. 41 at page 42.
