of the Warren B. Hunt place, on Saluda River, and
being known and designated upon a plat of same
made by B. M. James, Engineer, May 31st. 1920 as
lots nos. 8 and 8-a, and having the following metes

corner of lot no. 5 and 6, and running thence N. 74-30 E.
1625 to a point in Greenville Pickens Road; thence with
said road to a point in center of road, thence
