in the full and just sum of Twenty Five Dollars

year from date, four hundred dollars payable two  
years from date, and the balance three  
with interest thereon from date at the rate of Seven per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten Per Cent of  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Agnes O. Stone and E. E. Stone

Agnes O. Stone and E. E. Stone, all that certain  
piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and  
being in Paris Mountain Township, County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina about three miles  
from the Court House just off the National High-  
way and beginning at a stake at the north-west  
corner of Wedge-Wood Avenue, and an un-named  
sixty foot street and running thence with said  
unnamed street N. 73 P. one hundred and eighty  
feet to a stake on the west side of said street,  
thence in a westerly direction about two  
hundred feet to the north east corner of a lot  
sold to Bernice M. DeShazo this day, a distance  
of one hundred and seventy-four feet more or  
less, from Wedgewood Ave. thence with the  
eastern line of the said lot of Bernice M. DeShazo  
S. 71 30 E. One hundred and seventy-four feet to
