until paid in full or interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One Percent of the
indebtess besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor

bargain, sell and release unto the said Jessie T. Webster

Her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece
of land or lot of land situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina, said city and
County of Greenville, on Dunbar Street, and described
as follows:

Beginning on an iron pin on the north side of
Dunbar Street 75 feet from the corner of Leach
and Dunbar Streets, and running thence N. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.
parallel with Leach Street 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron
pin on side line of lot #6; thence with line of
said lot #6, N. 26 $\frac{2}{3}$ W. 75 feet to a stake on side
line of lot number 8; thence with line of lot #8,
S. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake on Dunbar Street, thence
with said Dunbar Street S. 26 $\frac{2}{3}$ E. 75 feet to the
beginning corner.
