This note is subject to garnishment besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. C. James, his heirs and assigns,

All that certain lot of land situated in Greenville Township in the county and state aforesaid just beyond the corporate limits of the city of Greenville and lying between the Woodside and Broadmoor Streets and known and designated as Lot No. 26, on a plat of that body of Land known as Percy Avenue Annex: Said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on the South side of Percy Avenue extending back a depth of (140) feet extending back to Bradford Avenue, fronting on said street (30) feet and containing (7000) square feet, more or less, and having the courses and dimensions as specified in plat of said Percy Avenue Annex, drafted by W. H. White, Engineer in March 1912, and duly recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book "C" at page 275 and 279.
