Until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. C. Harris, Guardian.

All that piece parcels or lot of land situate, lying, and being in the County and state aforesaid, being part of the land formerly owned by the Melrose Land Company and known as Melrose. Said lot being known and designated on a plat of said lands made by Carter & Pringle, Surveyors, as Lot number 21 of Block C, fronting 50 feet on Fremont Avenue.

Also the adjoining lot known and designated on said plat, as lot number 22 of said Block C and also fronting 50 feet on Fremont Avenue and being likewise a part of the tract formerly owned by the Melrose Land Company and known as Melrose.

Lot 21 being the same lot conveyed to me by deed by the Melrose Land Company said deed being dated September 18, 1920 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for said County in Vol. 7 page 70. Lot 22 being the same lot conveyed to me by the Melrose Land Company by deed dated September 21, 1920 and recorded in said office in Vol. 7 page 69.
