interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fees for one hundred fifty dollars
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as above thereof, if the same be placed in the hand of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind of which is secured under this mortgage, as in and by the said note, reference being
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said T. B. Moore, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying
and being in the State of South Carolina and County of
Greenville, in the Fifth Ward of the city of Greenville
beginning at a stake on the north-west corner of Pendleton
and Calhoun Streets and running hence with said
Pendleton Street in a westerly direction ninety-one (91)
feet to a stake on corner of a lot formerly belonging
to Bessie S. Lawton; thence along line of said lot in
a northerly direction one hundred and ninety-one (191)
feet to a stake on alley; thence with said alley in an
easterly direction ninety-one (91) feet to a stake on said
Calhoun street; thence with Calhoun street in a southerly
direction one hundred and ninety-one (191) feet to the
beginning corner; containing 17160 square feet, more
