at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. M. Swain*

All that piece parcel or lot of land situated on the west side of State Street between Burroughs and David Streets just beyond the corporate
limits of the City of Greenville in Greenville County, state aforesaid land
known on plat of the Mountain City Land and Improvement Company as
lot no 18 having the following miles and bounds:

Beginning at a point on the west side of State Street 102 feet from
the southwest corner of State and David Streets, thence $\text{N} 23\frac{1}{2} \text{ W}$. going
line of lot no 19 one hundred and twenty-one feet to a point in line
of lot now owned by W. L. Dunning, thence along line of last mentioned
lot $\text{S} 66\frac{1}{4} \text{ W}$. fifty-one feet, thence $\text{S} 23\frac{1}{2} \text{ E}$. 120 feet to a stake on
