I, Hattie M. Chiles (Nee Hattie M. Cox) of Simpsonville, S.C.

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Hattie M. Chiles (together with E.L. Chiles my husband)
in and by E.L. Chiles certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Mrs. L.O. Green of Simpsonville, S.C.

in the full and just sum of Six thousand

Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue

thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. L.O. Green, her heirs and executors, All that piece, parcel

and tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State
aforesaid, bounded by lands of J.H. Baldwin, J.H. Cox, W.F. Carrett, Allen J. Sullivan
and others, containing one hundred and eight (108) acres, more or less.

Also all that other tract of land adjoining the above said tract, also by lands of
R.L. Thompson and others, containing eight and one-half (8-1/2) acres, more or less - both
of which said tracts of land, being the same conveyed to me by Decature L. Bramlett
by deed bearing date Dec. 24, 1909 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for
Greenville County in Vol. NNN., at page 417 to which said deed reference is herein
