with interest thereon from January 17th 1922 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry P. McGee his heirs and assigns

All that part of my 9.3 acres of land where I reside in  
Garrett Township State & County aforesaid adjoining lands  
R. D. James George Myers Charles McLellant, Dan Johnson  
being all the land on the right of road leading from Dave  
McHugh's farm to W. C. Cleveland's land on Saluda River  
containing twenty acres more or less, being the rear portion  
of my farm.
