WHEREAS, I, Dock Bryson, the said Dock Bryson  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, em well and truly indebted to

V.M. Babb  
in the full and just sum of eighty-five  
Dollars, to be paid Greenville on or by November 1st, 1921 (\$85.00)

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) as and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Dock Bryson  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said V.M. Babb

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars, to Dock Bryson  
in hand well and truly paid by the said V.M. Babb

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said V.M. Babb, his heirs and assigns, and their piece, parcel or lot

of land lying, being and situate in the Town of Mountain Inn and in Greenville County  
and State aforesaid, containing Two and 9/10 (2.9) acres more or less and being the  
same lot of land conveyed to me by Deed of G.P. Woods and W.T. Thackston; said deed  
being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 444, at page 260 to  
which reference is made for a fuller description as to lines, courses and distances Ect.  
This being the same lot of land upon which my residence is situated, bounded on the  
South by Hellams Street on the West by Shaw Street on the North by lands formerly owned  
by the said Woods and Thackston and on the East by lands formerly owned by E.N. Garrett  
deceased; this being the 1st, and only mortgage or encumbrance on the above described  
property.
