Dollars, to be paid One hundred fifty Dollars Feb. 15, 1921, Two

hundred fifty Dollars May 15, 1921, two hundred  
fifty Dollars Aug. 15, 1921  
with interest thereon from 1st day of Dec. 1920 at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one hundred dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

bargain, sell and release unto the said H. C. Bennett, his heirs and assigns

forever.

Court House, beginning at stake of corner of  
A. S. Duncan, thence, S. 80 1/2 W. 4.32 cho to Stake  
XOM thence; S. 9. 6 1/2 Cho to stake XOM thence  
N. 81 1/2 E. 4.23 Cho to pine XOM, thence N. 9 W. 4.6 cho  
to begining, containing two acres more or less, also  
one other piece containing ten feet square on  
the south corner of the above two acres,  
and bounded by lands of said L.M. Hossett,  
Joseph Edwards, J. C. Smith, A. S. Duncan, and  
a street together with all and singular, the rights,  
member, hereditaments and appurtenances to
