I, Jim Bell, of Greenville, S.C. SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Jim Bell, the said Jim Bell
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

James Symmes, of Greenville, S.C.
in the full and just sum of Two hundred (\$200.00)
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from this 14th day of Oct 1922 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of
ten per cent on the amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Jim Bell, the said Jim Bell
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

James Symmes
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said James Symmes, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about One mile from the corporate limits
of the City of Greenville, near the Paris Mountain Road, containing one-half acre, more or less
and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of the
road leading to the Society Ground, and running thence with the Society Ground N. 19 W. 128.7
feet to iron pin in line of lands of W.H. Irvine; thence with Irvine line S. 71 W. 165 feet to
iron pin (which pin is 165 feet from a Cedar Tree); thence S. 19 E. 129.6 feet, more or less
to iron pin in road leading to Society Ground, and thence with said road N. 70 E. 165 feet to
the beginning corner. This is the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said Jim Bell by the
said James Symmes on Mar 29th, 1921 and this mortgage is given to secure a note for the
balance of the purchase money for the said lot.
