kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *John Rector*

securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
in hand well and truly paid at and the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release said *Nettie Hunt*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

*In the City of Greenville on the north side of East north street,
known as the Sarah Ward place, bounded by lots of Clara
Snead, J.P. McKee and Floyd, being the same conveyed
to me by B.M. McGee December 7, 1907, deed recorded in
Book 27, page 68, excepting the lot conveyed by me to W.A. Bates
June 13, 1914, deed recorded in Book 27, page 69. The lot above
described has a frontage of 115 feet on East north street
with a depth of 217 feet.*
