M. Bauckett all that piece, parcel, tract or land situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Beginning at the northwest corner of Woodlawn Ave. and Lola street and running thence N. 16-05 W. 50 feet along Woodlawn Avenue to pin at the joint corner of lots 1 and 2, thence S. 74-26 W. 105 feet to joint corner of lots 1 and 2, thence S. 15-20 E. 50 feet to iron pin on Lola street; thence with Lola street N. 74-26 E. 105 feet 8 inches to beginning, known as lot no. 1 as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 521, and also being a portion of lot no. 72 and no. 73 of the Donwood subdivision surveyed by R.
